

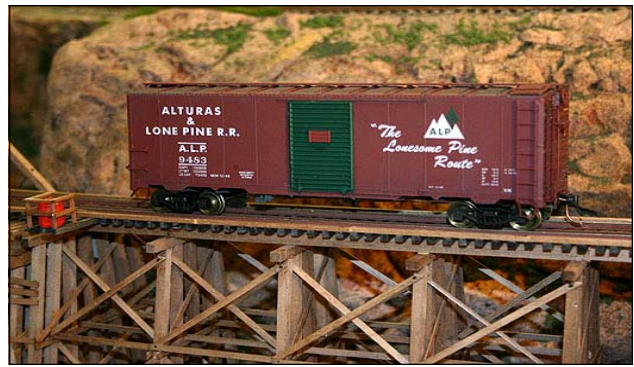
**LEHIGH VALLEY S GAUGERS
